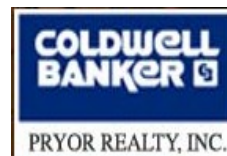

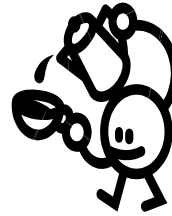

MCMINN ORTHOPAEDIC CLINIC—PART II



When Dr. David Robins offered the latest in orthopaedic surgery to Mrs. Margaret Bott, she hesitated--not

because she was afraid of being the first patient at Rhea Medical Center to have the procedure, but because she wanted to put off the surgery as long as possible. Dr. Robins had already done the least invasive surgery he could do to repair her knee, but found it severely damaged from a water skiing accident several years ago. Margaret was curious about this latest, less-invasive procedure, and decided to move forward instead of trying to manage the pain with medication. Most people in the community know Mrs. Bott as the Supervisor of the Adult Literacy Program at the Skills Center. She has been and continues to be active in community activities. Margaret said, "One of the reasons I chose this procedure and to be the first patient at Rhea Medical Center to have it done was so the people of Rhea County would know we have a lovely jewel of a

hospital serving us. There is no reason for people to go to Knoxville or Chattanooga when we have such a wonderful facility and the surgeon with superior skills right here in Dayton."
